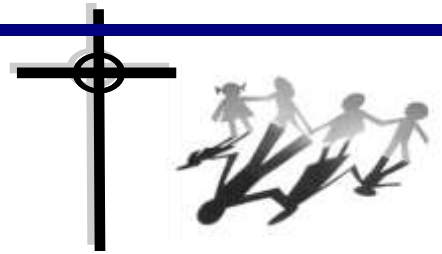

SETTING THE TABLE

This past weekend, our congregation hosted a Middle Tennessee event called “Setting the Table.” Fourteen Middle TN churches were represented—and one from Tupelo, MS! Eight of the almost fifty participants were from our own congregation.

We were joyful to be led in learning sessions by seminary representatives and SE Synod leaders. Bishop Julian Gordy presided over worship on Saturday. Pastor William Flippen, pastor of the only Lutheran church in Columbus, GA, preached a powerful message.

We Lutherans are learning how to talk to each other “cross-culturally.” It’s a piece of what might be called “Radical Welcome,” precisely the kind of welcome Jesus Christ practiced—and taught. What does it mean for us—Christ Lutheran Church, followers of Jesus—to *radically* welcome? *We’re finding out—and such welcome is connected to the community around us, to the relationship between each of us and the other of us.*

We began the workshop with the histories of different cultures around us. We heard the story of African-American Lutherans in the South, whose story is old and constant. In small groups, we got to the point of sharing feelings about those histories, about cultural traits of public discussion that have evolved out of those histories, and about how we view our worlds.

These stories help us to learn how to talk to our neighbors, and how to make it easy for them to talk to us, but such sharing also teaches us how to talk publicly with our fellow **members** and partners in ministry. We'll be using and developing these skills as we begin "Mission in Ministry" discussions on May 22nd.

We've "Set the Table." Won't you come and eat? Tell your story. Listen to mine. And then we'll reach out to those beyond our church walls in South Nashville, Tennessee.
